



# **Enforcement Performance Measures**








### PM3 | Investigations – Volume

Number of investigations closed (not including cases transmitted to the Attorney General).



(Includes intake and investigation.)




Target Average: 125 Days | Actual Average: 155 Days

### PM4 | Formal Discipline - Volume




### PM4 | Formal Discipline – Cycle Time<sup>2</sup>


